## Article 1.

### Scope

1. **INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL FOR PROJECTS - 3<sup>rd</sup> Edition** is a joint initiative of partner entities (promoters) that aims to promote among university students, professors, researchers and Startups the execution of innovative projects with local, national and international impact stimulating:
  - a. Technological and Digital Innovation in cybersecurity and other related areas;
  - b. Knowledge transfer between universities, research centers and INNCYBER's partner entities (public and private entities);
  - c. [Development of new business models, new products, new services and STARTUPS aimed at cybersecurity innovation, including areas such as Digital Transformation, Artificial Intelligence, Machine Learning, IoT, Cloud Security and Quantum Computing](#)
  
1. The promoters of **INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL FOR PROJECTS - 3<sup>rd</sup> Edition** are PremiValor Consulting, Altice Portugal, Altice Labs, EDP – Energias de Portugal and PwC Portugal, in articulation with other partner entities.

## Article 2.

### Objective

The objective of [INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL FOR PROJECTS - 3<sup>rd</sup> Edition](#) is to [put](#) minds from different education backgrounds collaborating on the development of ideas that can improve the cybersecurity and [cyberdefence](#) sectors, while awarding the best projects focused on innovation and entrepreneurship in the areas of digital transformation, cyber and IoT on each of the following categories:

- Students category: projects developed by Undergraduate, Postgraduate or Master students from national and international Universities and Institutes.
- Doctorates and researchers category: projects developed by doctorates, doctorate students or researchers.
- Startups category: Startups that are developing innovative products / solutions with high potential of growth / internationalization.

### Article 3.

#### Call for Projects Regulation

1. INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL FOR PROJECTS - 3rd Edition is governed by the present regulation in which the Monitoring Committee and the Jury are sovereign in their interpretation, application and gap integration.
2. The selection criteria and decision grounds, including the attribution of the awards to the winning projects, are exclusive competence of the promoters of the initiative. The decisions of the Monitoring Committee and Jury cannot be object of complaint or appeal, being always and in any circumstances unquestionable and definitive.
3. The promoters of INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL FOR PROJECTS - 3rd Edition are reserved to the right not to select a winning project in all categories if they conclude that there are no projects in the current edition that fit the minimum distinction requirements.

### Article 4.

#### **Duration, main phases and deadlines**

1. The third edition of INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL FOR PROJECTS will take place between November 2021 and November 2022.

2. The participation in [INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL FOR PROJECTS - 3rd Edition](#) comprises the following phases according with the calendar presented on the number 3 of this article:

- a) **Registration:** will occur in both semesters of the [2021/2022](#) academic year;
- b) **Project development:** will occur in both semesters of the [2021/2022](#) academic year;
- c) **Follow-up questionnaire:** during the project development phase, the participating groups will have to answer a brief [follow-up](#) questionnaire concerning the project development process;
- e)d) **Evaluation:** the project's evaluation process will take place after the reception of all projects. The analysis of all participating groups and selection of the projects that will attend the Final Award Ceremony is responsibility of the Jury;
- f)e) **Pitch Ceremony:** the [Pitch](#) Ceremony is the event where the groups with the best projects of each category are invited to present their projects. The winning group of each category will only be selected during the ceremony.

3. [INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL FOR PROJECTS - 3rd Edition](#) will have the following schedule:

4. Candidates who apply in the first semester and for some reason or impediment are unable to [submit](#) the project on the date stipulated for that purpose may also reapply in the second semester.

## Article 5.

### Topics of projects

1. [INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL FOR PROJECTS - 3rd Edition](#) aims for the development of innovative projects with local, national and international impact, enhancing the capacity of innovation in the development of more efficient strategies to approach cybernetic risk management.
2. The projects to be developed should focus on strategic areas of Cybersecurity, Cyber [defence](#), Cyber resilience [and](#) Digital Transformation, namely:
  - a) Security and vulnerabilities in the **5G World**;
  - b) **Internet of Things (IoT)**;
  - c) **Artificial Intelligence & Machine Learning applied to cybersecurity**;
  - d) **Cloud Security**;
  - e) [Security-by-Design \(SbD\)](#);
  - f) [Cybersecurity Certification](#);
  - e)g) [Cybersecurity Risk Management and Identification](#);

- f)h) New strategies to address **social engineering attacks**;
- g)i) **Ethics & Human Element of Cybersecurity** – bridging the gap between machines usage in cybersecurity and the human decision-maker;
- h)i) **Cyber Hygiene and GDPR**: Training program for the dissemination of good practices among users;
- i) **Microeconomics** applied to cybersecurity;

## Article 6.

### [INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL FOR PROJECTS - 3rd Edition](#)

#### Promotion

For a better understanding of the scope and objectives of [INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL FOR PROJECTS - 3rd Edition](#) a set of actions will take place to promote the project in Universities, Institutes [and Research Centres](#).

## Article 7.

### Application requirements

The requirements to participate in [INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL FOR PROJECTS - 3rd Edition](#) are:

#### [1. Students Category:](#)

Students interested in participating in [INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL FOR PROJECTS - 3rd Edition](#) must apply individually or join a group of up to five members and meet the following requirements as at the time of the application:

- a) Attend an Undergraduate, Postgraduate or Master course in the academic year [2021/2022](#);
- b) Candidates who have completed their [undergraduate](#), postgraduate or master's degree in the academic year [2020/2021](#);



- c) Participants in the previous edition of [INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL FOR PROJECTS](#) may reapply to this edition if they fulfil the requirements established in a) or b) of this article;
- d) The groups can be composed by elements from different universities, levels of graduation (Undergraduate, Postgraduate or Master) and from different areas of knowledge to promote multidisciplinary and complementarity;
- e) The groups can include one or more supervisors or advisors with knowledge and skills in the areas covered by [INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL FOR PROJECTS](#). The absence of a supervisor or advisor is not an exclusion factor of the group in the competition.

## [2. Doctorates and Researchers Category:](#)

The requirements to participate in Doctorates and Researchers category are:

- a) Have a PhD/Doctorate degree; or
- b) Attend in the present academic year ([2021/2022](#)) a PhD/Doctorate program;
- c) Be a researcher in a University, Institute or Research Center.

## [Startups Category:](#)

- a) [The company should have a product/service present in the market or a product/service with a TRL of 7 to 9.](#)

It is not allowed to compete simultaneously [Students and Doctorates and Researchers category with the same project.](#)

## Article 8.

### Application procedures

1. Candidates who fulfil the conditions required in the previous article must formalize their applications by completing the form provided by the Monitoring Committee

2. Along with the application form, all participants should provide the following documents:

#### [Students and Doctorates and Researchers category](#)

2.1 For those who fit in article 7 a) should provide a document proving attendance of a university/institute in the academic year [2021/2022](#) (e.g. student card).

2.2 For those who fit in article 7 b) should provide a document proving attendance of a university/institute in the academic year [2020/2021](#).

2.3 For those who fit in article 7 f) or 7 g) should provide a copy of the certificate/document of the PhD/Doctorate degree or PhD student.

2.4 For those who fit in article 7 h) should provide a document proving their condition from University, Institute or Research Center.

#### [Startup category](#)

2.5 [Formal document with information about the company, namely indication of the owners of the company, foundation date, etc. \(e.g. access code to “certidão permanente”\)](#)

3. The formalization of the application means the acceptance, without reservation or conditions, by the interested parties of the terms and regulation of this [call](#)

[for projects](#), as well as the express authorization to verify the authenticity of the respective documents made available.

## Article 9.

### Monitoring process

1. The monitoring process aims to assist the participants during the development of the projects.
2. The follow-up process includes the fulfilment of a questionnaire provided by the [INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL FOR PROJECTS - 3rd Edition](#) Monitoring Committee to the participants.
3. The [follow-up](#) questionnaire [is available on the INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB's website](#).
- 3.4. [The submission the follow-up questionnaire should be done](#) according with number 3 of article 4.
- 4.5. [Within a period of two weeks following the follow-up questionnaire submission deadline, the Monitoring Committee will provide feedback to each group.](#)
- 5.6. [If necessary, the Monitoring Committee may request the groups to submit additional information or to provide some clarifications regarding the project.](#)
- 6.7. [The participants may contact the Monitoring Committee during the project development period to obtain any clarifications \(important note: The Monitoring Committee will not provide classified information or information that may affect the competitiveness and independence of the competition\).](#)

## Article 10.

### Project [submission](#) procedures

1. The report must be submitted in a PDF format.

2. The report can be written in English (preferably), Portuguese or Spanish languages. If the report is written in Portuguese or Spanish, it must include a detailed abstract in English.
3. As a guideline, it is suggested that the projects do not exceed 30 pages (Word format) or 50 slides (PowerPoint format), excluding annexes such as graphic material, videos, market research analysis, programming code or other elements that are considered relevant.
4. [The projects submitted can include one or more videos](#)

5. The report and any content related to the project should be submitted to the following email: **INNCYBER\_innovation\_HUB@premivalor.com**. Files should be sent in non-editable format such as PDF format. If the project is composed by several documents, the participants should send a ZIP file containing all the documents.
6. If the uploaded files exceed 5 Mb they can be placed on online platforms (e.g. WeTransfer, Google Drive, etc.) and an email should be sent to **INNCYBER\_innovation\_HUB@premivalor.com** sharing the link for download.
7. With the project's submission, the groups must also send the Final Project [Summary](#), available on [INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB's](#) web page.
8. Any questions or doubts regarding project submission procedures should be emailed to **INNCYBER\_innovation\_HUB@premivalor.com**.
9. The projects and the Final Project [Summary](#) should be delivered according to the deadlines stipulated in Article 4.

## Article 11.

### Monitoring Committee and Jury

1. The whole process of launching, processing, interpretation of the Regulation, awarding and implementation of [INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL FOR PROJECTS - 3rd Edition](#) will be the responsibility of the Monitoring Committee, composed by members of PremiValor Consulting, Altice Portugal, Altice Labs, EDP – Energias de Portugal, [PwC Portugal](#) and other partner organizations of the [INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB](#).
2. The members of the Monitoring Committee and Jury will be responsible for analyzing all the candidate projects to select the best projects of each category to attend the [Pitch](#) Ceremony.
- 4.3. The Jury has sole authority, and will decide sovereignly, according to the most appropriate criteria considering the objectives of the competition, which are outlined in the article 12.
- 5.4. The Jury is responsible for the final decision of the award attribution in each category. It is composed of members of the Monitoring Committee, joined by at least three other members, at minimum one of them being independent of the promoters of the initiative.

## Article 12.

### Evaluation Criteria

The evaluation of the projects [developed under Students and Doctorates and Researchers categories](#) is based on the following [criteria](#):

a) [Innovation of the project / solution - 40%](#)

-b) [Methodology applied in the development of the project \(technical development and scientific component\) - 20%](#)

–c) Robustness of the product, service or solution proposed in terms of possible implementation - 15%

g) Business model (including economic viability of the project) (if applicable) - 15%

—Project presentation (formal report) - 10%

The evaluation of the participating Startups is based on the following criteria:

a) Innovation of the product(s), service(s) or solution(s) - 30%

b) Business model (including economic viability of the project or solution) - 30%

c) Potential of scalability - 20%

d) Importance of the product/service or solution for organizations and society - 20%

The Elevator Pitch performed at the Pitch Ceremony is also an Evaluation Criteria for all categories.

### Article 13.

#### Pitch Ceremony

1. The Pitch Ceremony is the event in which the best projects selected from each category will be presented publicly in an Elevator Pitch format:

a. Students Category: 10 projects selected

b. Doctorates and Researchers Category: a maximum of 5 projects will be selected;

b.c. Startups Category: A maximum of 5 Startups will be selected.

2. At the Pitch Ceremony, the jury will evaluate the finalist projects and the winner of each category of INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL

will be known.

3.4. The non-attendance of at least one group member at the [Pitch Ceremony](#) is an exclusion [criterion](#).

4.5. All participants groups will be invited to attend the [Pitch](#) Ceremony.

5.6. Details of the participation in the [Pitch](#) Ceremony will be made available to the finalist groups well in advance so that they can prepare their participation.

6.7. The groups invited to the [Pitch](#) Ceremony expressly commit to the disclosure of their image and data regarding the challenge promotion, the beneficiaries themselves, their Academic Institutions and of the Promoters of the event.

#### **Article 14.**

##### **Communication of the decision**

1. After the evaluation of the finalist projects, the decision to award the [INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL FOR PROJECTS - 3rd Edition](#) will be disclosed and communicated during the Ceremony.
2. There will be no isolated communications about the projects during the work development period.

#### **Article 15.**

##### **Intellectual property of candidate projects**

1. The intellectual property of the candidate projects belongs to their authors.
2. The reports related to the projects submitted to the [Call for Projects](#) will not be returned to the candidates, with the management of the [Call for Projects](#) allowed to disclosed them generally.

## Article 16.

### Award Rights

1. Awards will be assigned based on the technical evaluation of the projects carried out by the INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL FOR PROJECTS - 3rd Edition Jury.

#### 1.1 Students category:

##### First Place

- a) The winning project will be awarded a prize of an amount equivalent to € 5,000 (five thousand euros), comprised of a monetary amount of € 2,000 (two thousand euros) and € 3,000 (three thousand euros) in dedicated mentoring hours from experienced professionals with expertise in business modelling, finance, business development and other relevant areas

- b) If the winning group is accompanied by one or more supervisors or advisors, a total gross monetary amount of € 1,000 (one thousand euros) will be awarded to the supervisor(s) or advisor(s).

##### Second Place

- c) The second-place project will be awarded a prize of an amount equivalent to € 2,500 (two thousand and five hundred euros), comprised of a monetary amount of € 1,000 (one thousand euros) and € 1,500 (one thousand and five hundred euros) in dedicated mentoring hours from experienced professionals with expertise in business modelling, finance, business development and other relevant areas

- d) If the winning group is accompanied by one or more supervisors or advisors, a total gross monetary amount of € 750 (seven hundred and fifty euros) will be awarded to the supervisor(s) or advisor(s).

##### Third place

- e) The third-place project will be awarded a prize of an amount equivalent to € 1,000 (one thousand euros), comprised of a monetary amount of € 500 (five hundred



euros) and € 500 (five hundred euros) in dedicated mentoring hours from experienced professionals with expertise in business modelling, finance, business development and other relevant areas.

- f) If the winning group is accompanied by one or more supervisors or advisors, a total gross monetary amount of € 500 (five hundred euros) will be awarded to the supervisor(s) or advisor(s).

#### 1.2 Doctorates and Researchers category:

##### First Place

- a) The winning project will be awarded a prize of an amount equivalent to € 7,000 (seven thousand euros), comprised of a monetary amount of € 2,000 (two thousand euros) and € 5,000 (five thousand euros) in dedicated mentoring hours from experienced professionals with expertise in business modelling, finance, business development and other relevant areas

##### Second Place

- b) The second-place project will be awarded a prize of an amount equivalent to € 3,500 (three thousand and five hundred euros), comprised of a monetary amount of € 1,000 (one thousand euros) and € 2,500 (two thousand and five hundred euros) in dedicated mentoring hours from experienced professionals with expertise in business modelling, finance, business development and other relevant areas.

##### Third Place

c) The third-place project will be awarded a prize of an amount equivalent to € 3,500 (three thousand and five hundred euros), comprised of a monetary amount of € 500 (five hundred euros) and € 1,500 (one thousand and five hundred euros) in dedicated mentoring hours from experienced professionals with expertise in business modelling, finance, business development and other relevant areas.

If the 5 finalist projects (TOP 5) of Student Category and the projects selected of the Doctorates and Researchers category to be present at the ceremony create a startup company in the Region Autonomous of Madeira within 1 year after the date of the Pitch Ceremony, will be awarded an additional prize of an amount equivalent to € 1,000 (one thousand euros), comprised of a monetary amount of € 500 (five hundred euros) and € 500 (five hundred euros) in dedicated mentoring hours from experienced professionals with expertise in business modelling, finance, business development and other relevant areas.

#### 1.3 Startup Category

##### First Place

a) The winning project will be awarded a prize of an amount equivalent to € 6,000 (six thousand euros), comprised of a monetary amount of € 1,000 (one thousand euros) and € 5,000 (five thousand euros) in dedicated mentoring hours from experienced professionals with expertise in business modelling, finance, business development and other relevant areas.

##### Second Place

b) The second-place project will be awarded a prize of an amount equivalent to € 3,000 (three thousand euros), comprised of a monetary amount of € 500 (five hundred euros) and € 2,500 (two thousand and five hundred euros) in dedicated mentoring hours from experienced professionals with expertise in business modelling, finance, business development and other relevant areas.

##### Third Place

c) The third-place project will be awarded a prize of an amount equivalent to € 2,000 (two thousand euros), comprised of a monetary amount of € 500 (five hundred euros) and € 1,500 (one thousand and five hundred euros) in dedicated mentoring hours from experienced professionals with expertise in business modelling, finance, business development and other relevant areas.

2.2 The right to the award is automatically and definitively extinguished, and without the need for any specific formalism, if any of the following occur:

- a) It is concluded that there is some irregularity in the application of the winning group or project;
- b) There is evidence of the project being carried out by other members other than the members of the awarded group or project;
- c) Evidence of plagiarism;
- d) If the prize is not claimed within one year from the date of the [Pitch Ceremony](#);
- e) If, pending the benefit of the award, the winners are the subject of any criminal proceedings instituted by the State or disciplinary proceedings instituted by the institution of attendance of the course, or the Winners assume behaviour before the promoters, sponsors or third parties who, due to its severity, determine damage to the image and honourability of the participants or the discredit or injury to the entities involved or to themselves.

3.3 The award of the prize presumes a minimum number of 10 received projects in [Students](#) category, 3 projects in [Doctorates](#) and [Researchers](#) category and 5 [Startups](#). In case the minimum number of projects is not met in a given edition, the submitted projects are automatically enrolled to the following edition, giving the opportunity to the candidates to work in their development if they desire.

## Article 17.

### Changes to deadlines and dates in this Regulation

The deadlines and dates contained in this Regulation may be changed by decision of the promoters of [INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL FOR PROJECTS - 3rd Edition](#), who will publicly announce it.

## Article 18.

### Processing of [Personal Data](#)

1. Enrolment and participation in [INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL FOR PROJECTS - 3rd Edition](#) implies the collection and processing of personal data of the interested parties, for which PremiValor Consulting and the project partner entities are responsible, with the data to be processed for the purposes of verifying compliance with the conditions of participation, pursuing the due diligence and communications necessary for the participation and development of the projects and the delivery of the award, holding questionnaires, monitoring, development of the project evaluation process and public disclosure of the image and identification data of the interested parties classified for the award. These purposes are based on the consent of the data subject, provided through the application form.
2. The responsible undertake to comply at all times with the legal duties arising from the processing of personal data, including compliance with the appropriate technical and organizational security measures to ensure data protection with a view to compliance with applicable legislation on the protection of personal data, in particular Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016.
3. The collection and processing of personal data of interested parties is a necessary requirement for entry and participation in [INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL FOR PROJECTS - 3rd Edition](#). Failure to provide or incomplete or incorrect data may make it impossible to participate in [INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL FOR PROJECTS - 3rd Edition](#).

4. In cases where the processing of personal data is performed solely on the consent of the holder, the holder has the right to withdraw his consent at any time. The withdrawal of consent, however, does not compromise the legality of the treatment based on the consent previously given.
5. Anyone wishing to participate in [INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL FOR PROJECTS - 3rd Edition](#), by submitting an application identifying a third party's personal data, must first ensure that has provided the third party with the information present in this Regulation and obtained the respective consent of the third party for the communication of their personal data to the responsible for the strict purposes set out in this clause.
6. The personal data of participating students and professors will be retained by the holder until the conclusion of the edition of [INNCYBER INNOVATION HUB - CALL FOR PROJECTS - 3rd Edition](#) in which they participated, after which it will be deleted unless, under applicable law or regulation, or due to pending litigation, retention for a longer period is mandatory.
7.
